

Inclement Weather Policy

When there is inclement weather, the decision to come to church or not is yours to make and should be made considering your safety and comfort in mind. This decision should not be based on whether you have a "job" to do at church on a Sunday morning. Even if there is a special event, make your decision based on your safety.

The bottom line is that Sunday services will never be "cancelled" at St. Stephens. What happens during church may be changed, but someone will be here and will have the door unlocked and coffee made. At the very bare minimum, a fellowship of two or three will happen. If enough people feel safe enough to travel, we will have the Eucharist. If I am on vacation, and the supply priest is unable to make the trip, then worship will be led by lay leaders if enough folks brave the weather to come.

On weekdays the Parish Office may be closed. If you were planning to attend a class, event or small group, please check with leadership to see if it has been cancelled. Keep in mind that if we have closed the office, you should probably stay home too.
